



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Hopewell Township in the County of York being part of a larger Tract of Land, originally surveyed by William Matthes late D.S. on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of the 9<sup>th</sup> month 1768. In pursuance of the Application N<sup>o</sup>. 2829 for 100<sup>a</sup> dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 1767 Granted to William Sinclair who sold the same to Samuel Harper. And now on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Domini 1805 at the request of the Present Owner, Andrew Anderson, we are desired to make return of the Draught & as calculated, examined and corrected find it to contain Seventy four Acres 8 Sixty three Perches & the usual allowance of Six Acres Per Cent &c.
