



Situate on Sandy Creek, in Wharton township Fayette County, and surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November 1854 in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Richard Rose for 400<sup>ac</sup> of land dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February 1794. There is 3 dwelling houses, 2 barns & a few fruit trees and 20 or 80 acres cleared on this tract, and the <sup>first</sup> improvement must be from 40 to 50 years old.
