



Situate on Stony Run, a branch of Daltlick Creek in Daltlick Township Fayette County and surveyed the 29th day of October 1830 and 2th of February 1831 in pursuance of two Warrants in the name of Joseph Brooks; the one for 200 acres dated the 9th day of March 1830 the other for 50 acres dated the 17th day of January 1831.
