



By Virtue of a Warrant dated September 2th 1789 surveyed the 12th day of July 1793 to Sam-
 uel Baird the above tract of Land situate on the most southerly Branch of Equinusk
 Creek about five and a half miles from the River Delaware in Northampton County
 Containing four hundred and thirty seven acres and seventeen perches and the usual
 allowance of six percent for Roads &c.
