In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Isaac Roe for 400^{ac} dated the 5th day of February ¹⁷⁹⁴~~1835~~. There is about 15 acres in a state of cultivation, has been improved about 15 years. Also two cabin houses & two families residing on this tract.
