



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Nicholas Byerly on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Eighty nine containing in Breadth North and South on Fawn Street Sixty feet, and in Length East & West on Poakberry Street Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Northward by Poakberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Meadow Alley Southward by Lot Number One hundred and Ninety, and Westward by Fawn Street. Returned into the Secretary's office the 29th July 1774 by Warrant dated the 28th day of July 1774.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this third day of November 1903
