



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772, a Survey was made on the 3d day of July following for John Tucker on a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumb.^{da} marked in a General plan of said Town Number One hundred and three. Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Dewberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Dewberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Two, Northward by Strawberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and four.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this third day of November 1903
