



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th. day of June 1772 a Survey was made on a certain Lot of Ground for Samuel Brooks on the 3^d. day of July following Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland. marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred and Seventeen. containing in Breadth East and West on Cranberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Eastward by Deer Street, Northward by Cranberry Street, Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and Eighteen, and Southward by Strawberry Alley. Returned into the Secretarys office the 20th. day of March 1776 for George Buyers by Warrant dated the 19th. Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this first day of December 1903
