



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for John King on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in the Plan of said Town Number One Hundred and Twenty four containing in Breadth East and West on Cranberry Street Sixty feet, and in length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Cranberry Street, Westward by River Street, Southward by Strawberry Alley, and Eastward by Lot Number One Hundred and Twenty three. Returned into the Secretary's office the 20th day of March 1776 by Warrant granted to John Buyers, dated the 19th of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this first day of December 1903
