



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for Christopher Smith on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred and Two containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Dewberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred and thirty feet Bounded Southward by Dewberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number One Hundred and One, Northward by Strawberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and Three. Returned into the Secretary's office the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1776 for Nehemiah Breese by Warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this first day of December 1903
