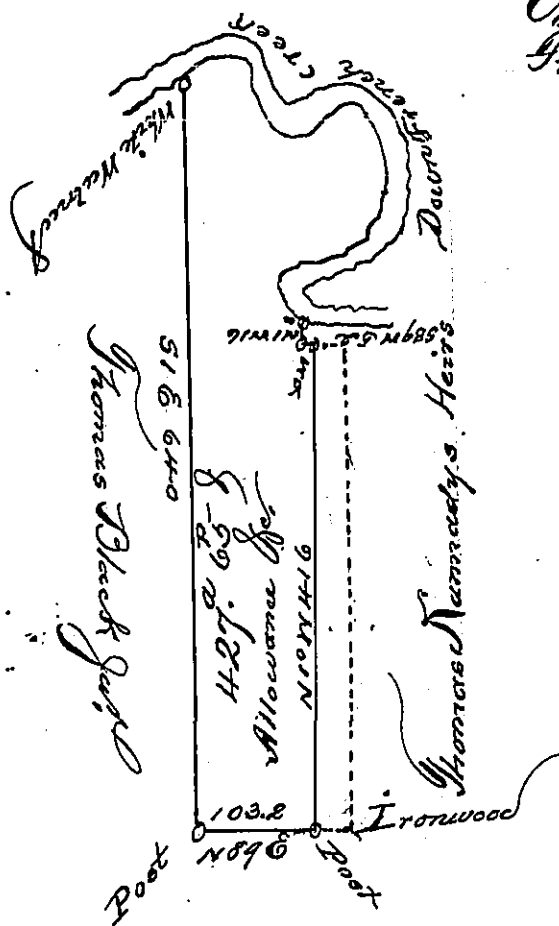


The Improvement contains about sixty acres with a house Barn & some fruit trees the settlement was commenced in June, 1793 and is continued

A Draught of a tract of Land Containing four hundred twenty seven acres sixty five perches and a fraction. Situate on the East side of French Creek in Le Boeuff Township Erie County surveyed 20<sup>th</sup> July 1814 to William Black In Virtue of his warrant dated 11<sup>th</sup> January 1811, resurveyed November the 22<sup>nd</sup> November 1820 in pursuance of a decree of the Court of Common Pleas of Erie County of the 2<sup>nd</sup> of February 1819, fixing and establishing the division line between the claims of William Black and Thomas Black Junr
