



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 1st July 1784, surveyed the 14th October 1786, to Marcus Brink the above described tract of land situate on a creek called Strawders Creek about a mile from the Mokok branch of Delaware and about three miles south of the State line in Northampton County, containing four hundred and twenty five acres 135 perches and the allowance of six ft. Cent. &c.
