



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772, a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772, for Thomas McCordell of the County of Northumberland of a certain Lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland aforesaid, marked in the General Plan of said Town, Number Ninety Nine, Containing in Breadth East and West on Strawberry Alley sixty feet, and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet, Bounded Northward by Short Street, Eastward by Lot number Ninety eight, Southward by Strawberry Alley aforesaid, and Westward by Lot number One hundred, Returned into the Secretary's Office the 1st day of December, 1773, for John Boyd by Warrant dated the 30th November 1773.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of July, 1903,
