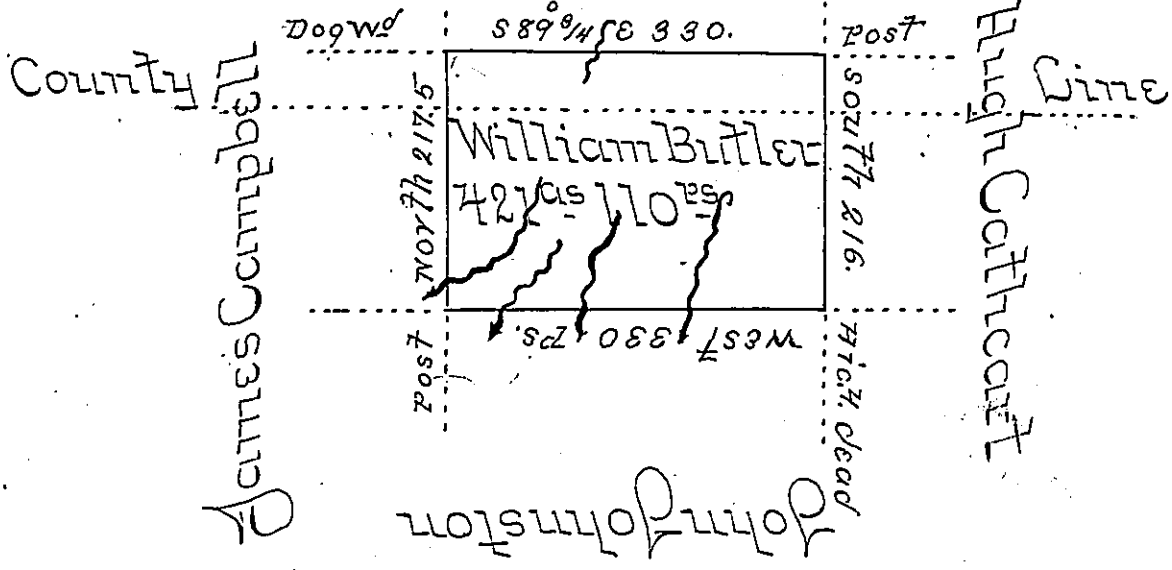


Crawford Thomas Meno County
