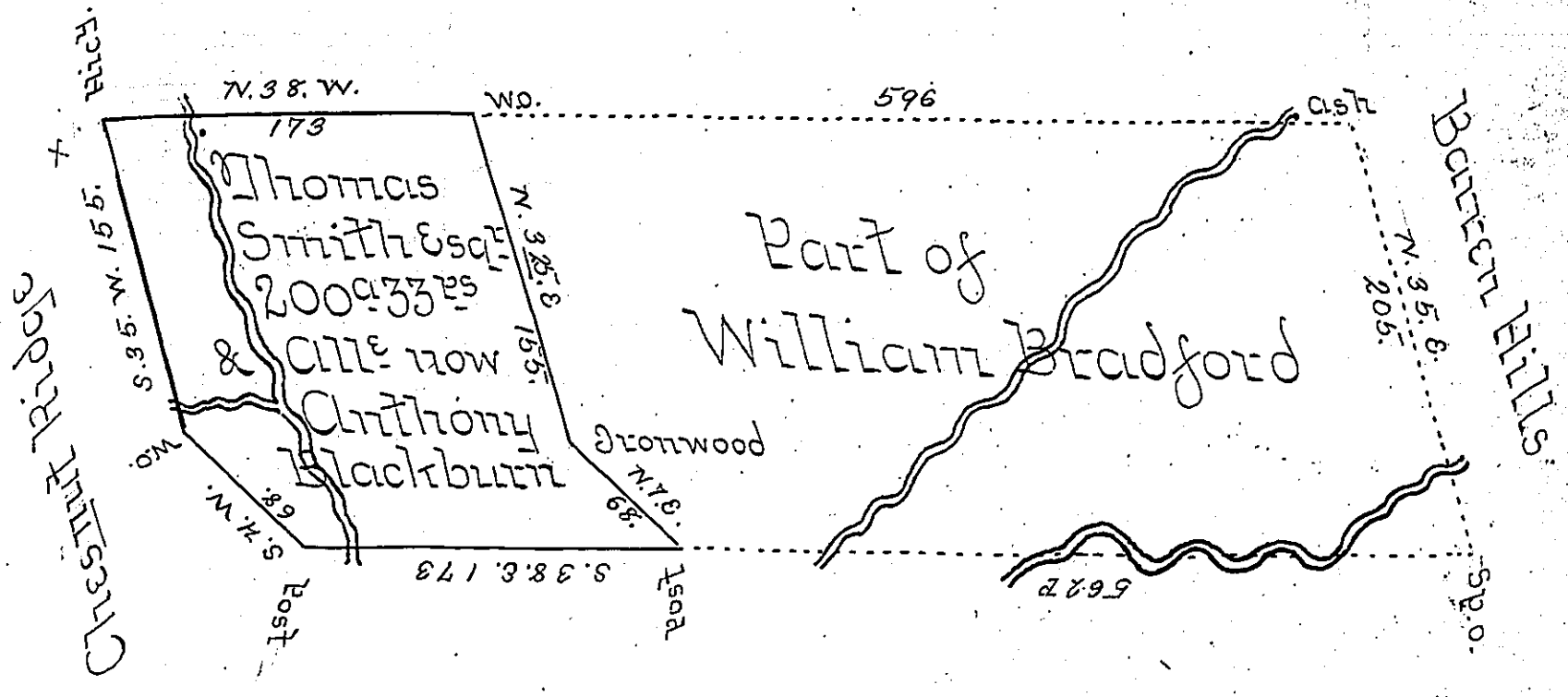


In the Commisⁿ. Deed Called Tho^s Drungold

The above is a Draft of a Tract of Land situated on the South West Branch of Drummings Creek (formerly Cumberland) Now Bedford County containing Two hundred Acres and thirty three perches with the Allowance for Roads &c. Conveyed by the Commissioners of Bedford County To Thomas Smith Esq^r by Deed Dated December 31st 1774 (now Claimed by Anthony Blackburn) being part of a Tract of Land containing 653 1/2 Acres & Allowance &c^a surveyed May 21st 1765 on Warrant in the Name of William Bradford Dated June 3^d 1763 - Deided agreeably to the said Commissioners Deed May 17th 1799 & in pursuance of a Special Order Dated May 3^d 1799.
