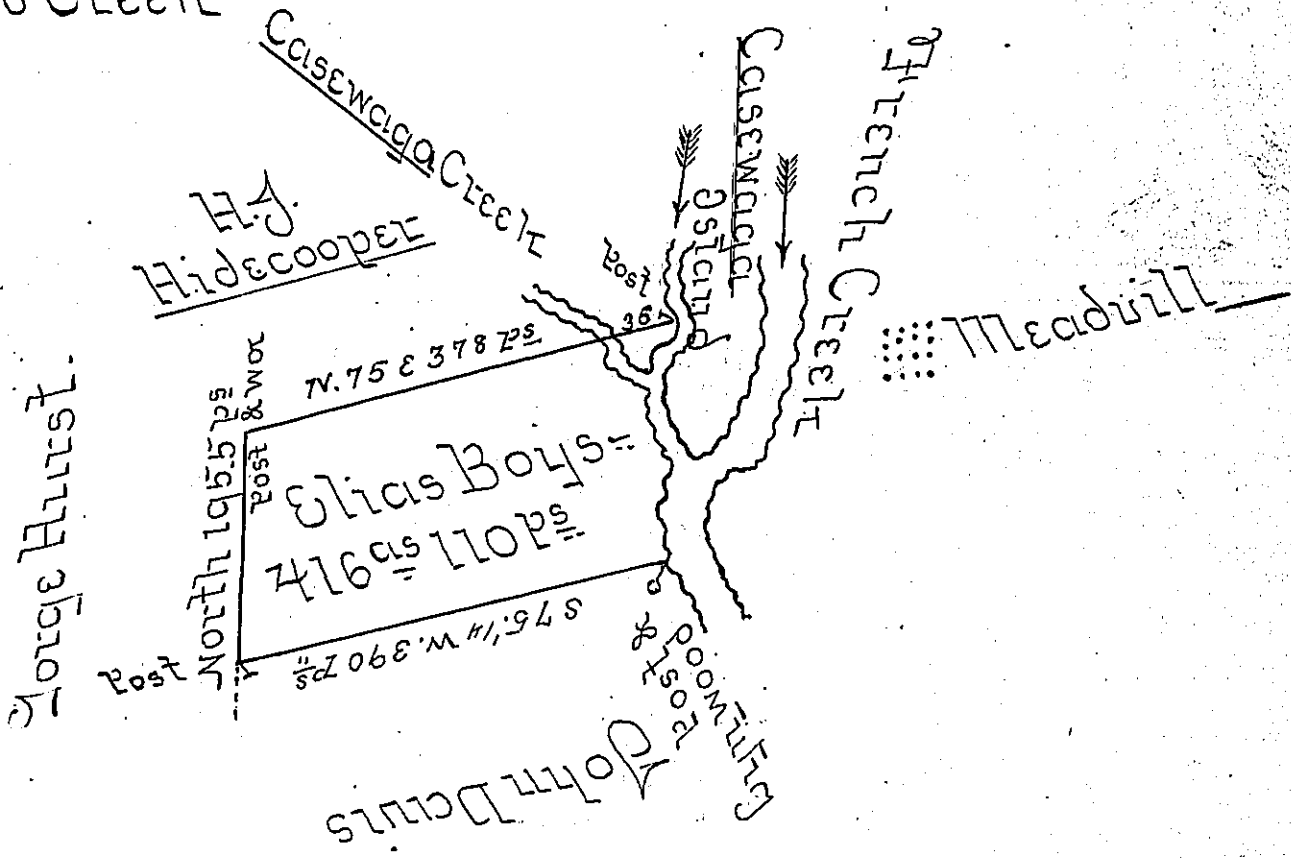

In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres granted to Elias Boys, bearing date the 13th day of April 1792 Was Resurveyed on the 14th day of August, 1819 the above described tract of land containing 416^{acs} 110^{perches} and allowance of six ^{per} cent. for Roads &c. Situate on the West side of and adjoining French Creek including the Mouth of Cassewaga Creek, in Mead Township Crawford County Pa it being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 2^d day of June 1794 for John Little in Pursuance of an Improvement, and that the same is agreeable to the original Marked lines, except the creek Courses, it having shifted its bed in a small degree and at the time of Making said Survey David Thompson was Residing thereon with his family under H. J. Hidecooper the Present owner of the same.
