



A Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Guilford Township Franklin County Containing Three hundred and six acres & fifty three perches & allowance of six p. cent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger Tract of Five hundred and sixty eight acres & allowance which was surveyed to Thomas Beard the 11th day of March 1765 in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 1st day of July 1762. Resurveyed and divided off by Daniel Henderson Esqr (formerly Deputy Surveyor) on the 29th day of May 1802 as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in this office Examined this 25th day of December 1809
