



A Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Guilford Township Franklin County containing Three hundred and six acres & fifty three perches & allowance of six p. cent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger Tract of Five hundred and sixty eight acres & allowance which was surveyed to Thomas Beard the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1765 in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1762. Resurveyed and divided off by Daniel Henderson Esqr (formerly Deputy Surveyor) on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May 1802 as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in this office Examined this 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1809
