



In Pursuance of a warrant granted to John Boyd dated The 27th Day of September 1808 Surveyed on the 29th day of October 1811 unto the aforesaid John Boyd the above described tract of land containing one hundred and three acres and one hundred perches & eight tenths of a perch. Situate adjoining Lands of Robert Gilson on the North. Samuel & Moses Donnel's Heirs on the East & South ~~and~~ David McCown & Henry Boyd on the waters of spruce run in Perry township in the County of Westmoreland Including his improvement consisting of a Dwelling house a barn & other Buildings and about forty acres of land cleared &c first commenced to be improved in March 1776
