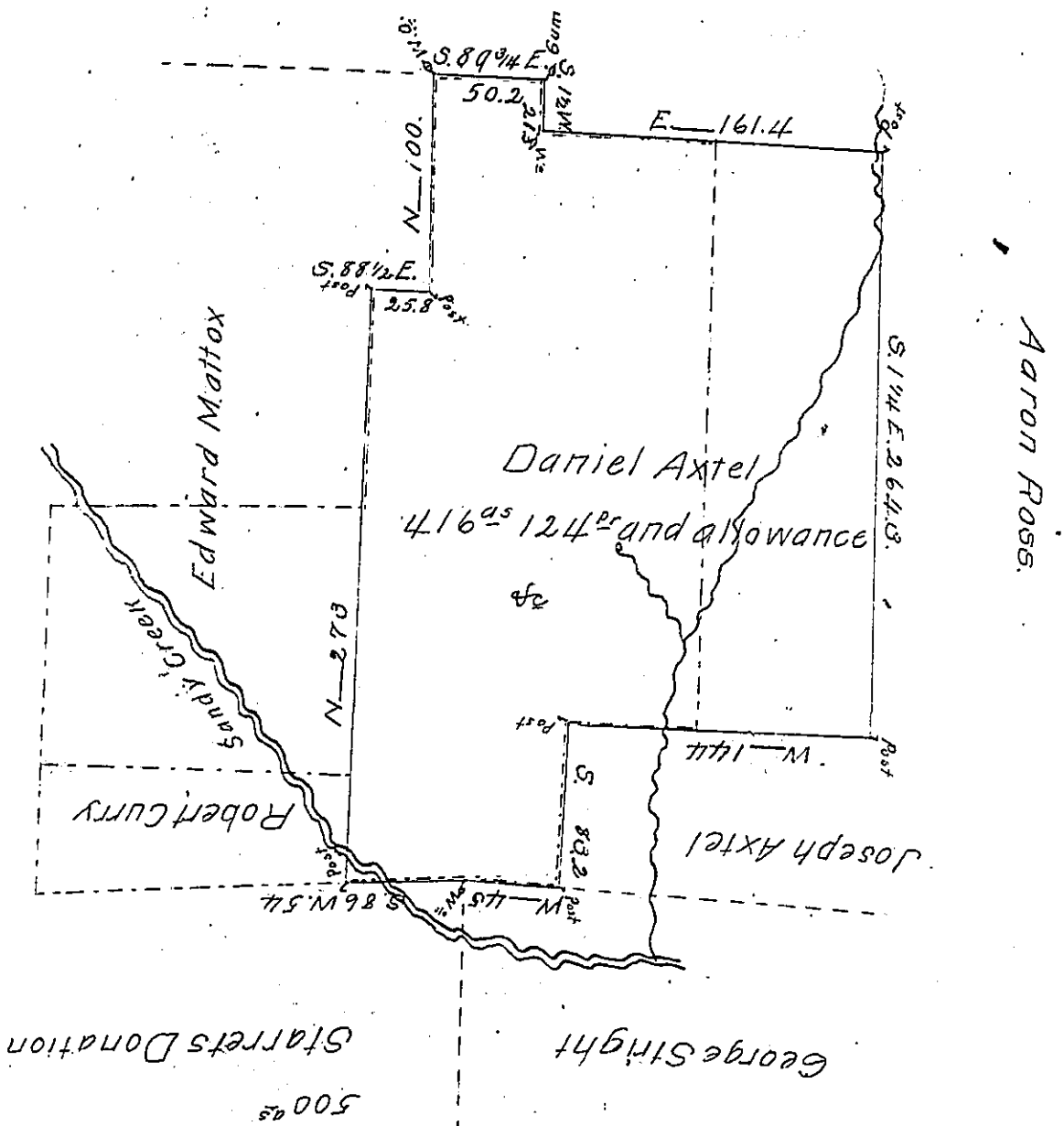


Thomas Collans, s Heirs



In pursuance of a Warrant dated 13th December 1803 and an order of the Board of Property dated May 4th 1820 I have resurveyed the 24th day of May 1820 to Daniel Axtel the above described tract of land. Situate in Sandy-creek township Mercer county (The dotted lines representing the figure and shape of the original survey with the interferences) ~~the~~ the black lines that of the resurvey excluding the lands interfered with, and embracing other land which till now was vacant, containing clear of interferences 416^{ac} 124^{ac} and allowance of Six per cent.
