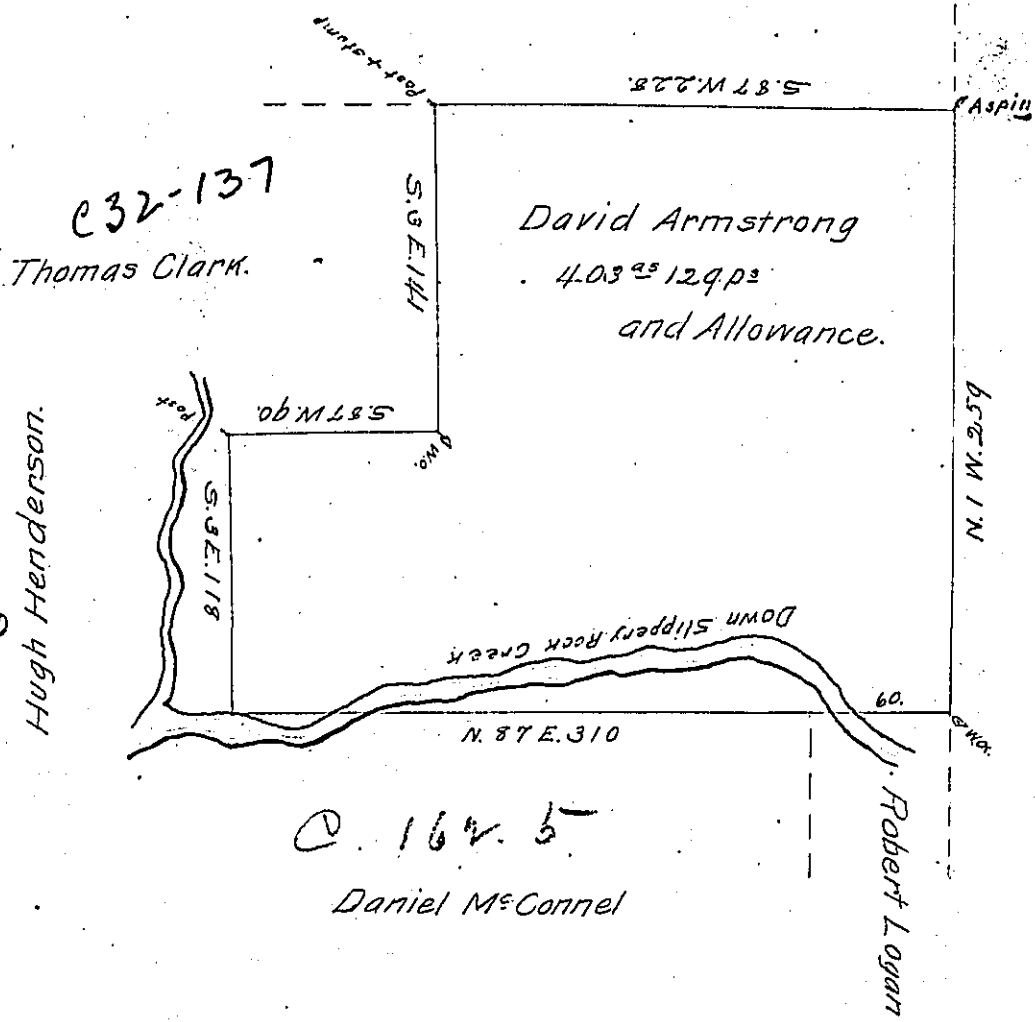


John Burres
