The above is a draft of a tract of land surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> of September A.D. 1828, in pursuance of the actual Settlement of William Albion Situate in Springfield Township Mercer County and now 2<sup>d</sup> day of March 1830. In pursuance of a warrant granted to William Albion bearing date the twenty first day of March A.D. 1829. Bounded as above described, containing four hundred and forty two acres and sixty perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads, this tract was early settled, well improved, and two families living on it at the time of surveying. Settlement commenced in March 1799
