Surveyed on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sept 1814. of that Survey there is included in the above 74<sup>ac</sup> 56<sup>1/2</sup>. The other warrant dated 19<sup>th</sup> Decr 1814 & Surveyed on the 31<sup>st</sup> Decr 1814. of this last mentioned Survey there is included by the above 16<sup>ac</sup> 37<sup>1/2</sup> &c.
