In pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property Dated the 25th day of May 1808. Granted to John P. Mc-Knight. The resurvey Was Said to Contain 216 Acres 34 perches &c. This part Resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 29th day of April A. D. 1831.
