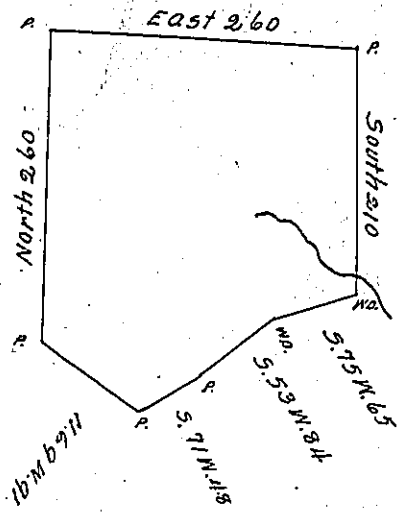

The above is the draught of a survey made March 5th 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Barron Junior on the 25th day of April 1793 Situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the waters of Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to William Johnston called Luzerne containing 394 Acres & 144 perches with the usual allowance of 6 p. Cent &c.
