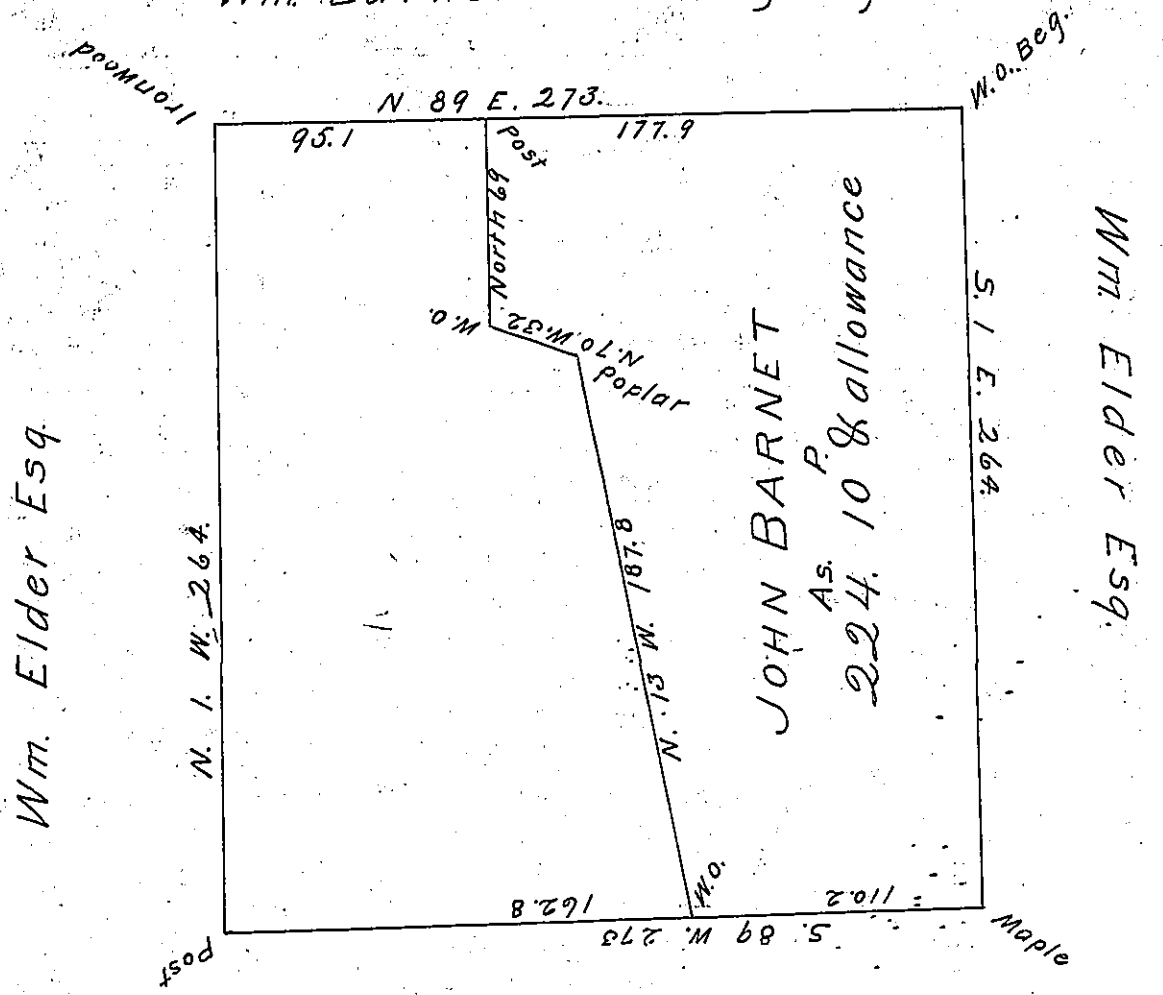


Wm. Barnet & Wm. Laughrage
