



A Draught of a Tract of land called — Situate on the East side of the North East branch of Susquehanna River adjoining land Granted to John Brown between Quittemack and Lahawanack Creeks in the County of Northumberland containing two hundred and forty two Acres and One hundred and forty perches besides the usual allowance of six  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the third day of June 1775 for Elijah Brown In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 15 June 1774.
