



Situate in Warrior-Mark township Huntingdon County, Containing three hundred eleven acres and half & the usual allowance the same being part of a tract of land originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Baynton & Samuel Wharton Dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 1766- The Original Survey Was said to contain 519 1/4 Acres. This part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Feby - A. D 1838
