



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Washington Township in the County of Franklin containing one hundred and ninety one acres 131 perches and the allowance of six Cent per Acre Survey'd November 6th 1802 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jeremiah Burns bearing Date 24th August 1802. The Improvements on this Tract are a small cabin & 4 or 5 acres cleared & were made by a certain John Colhoon 2 or 3 years ago who still lives on the Land - Jeremiah Burns (I believe) agreed with Colhoon (who is a poor man) that he would take a warrant including said Colhoon's Improvement and after Patenting would convey him Fifty acres off any part of it
