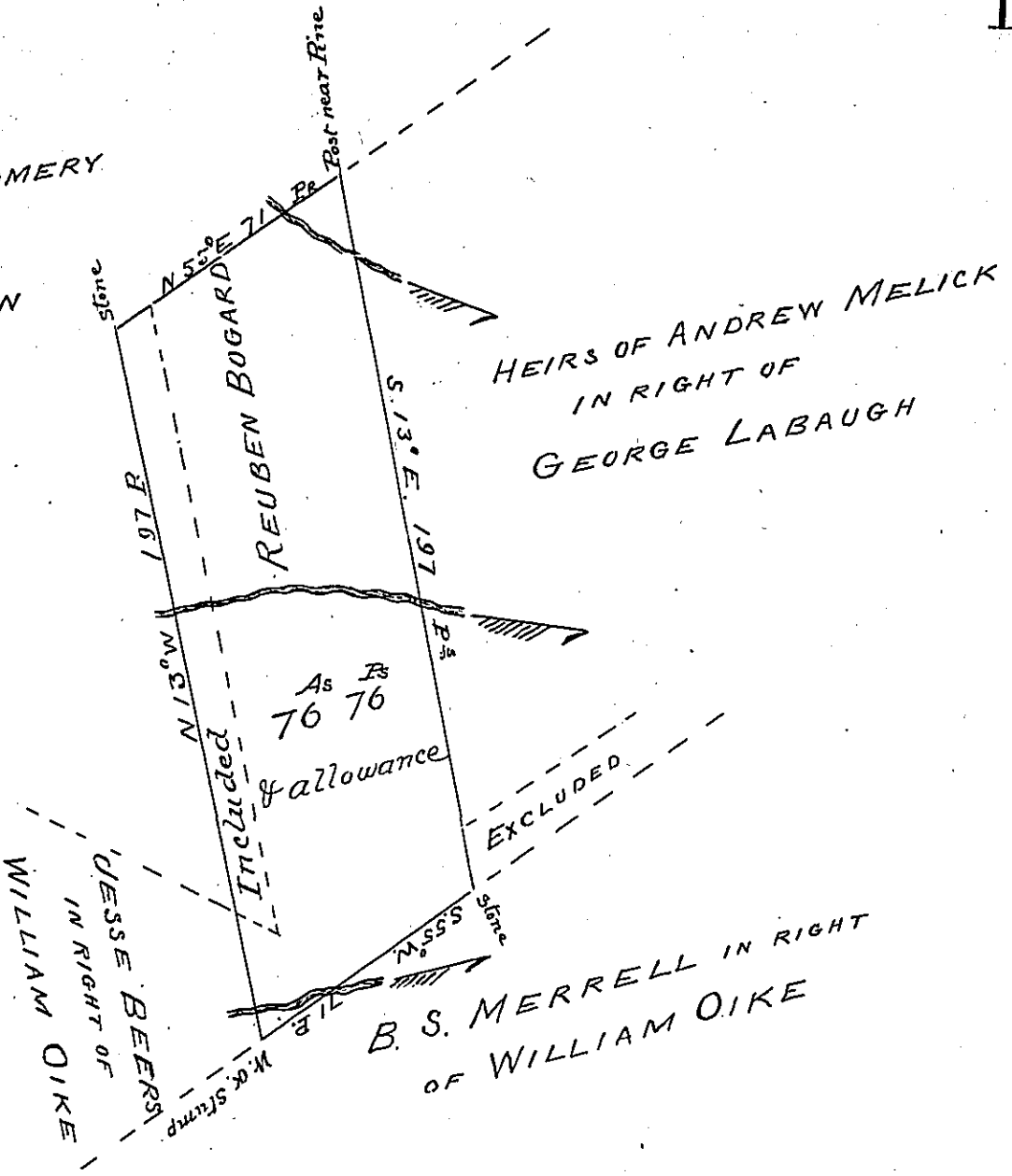

vey from the Board of Property dated the 10th day
of November A. D. 1853. Containing Seventy Six
Acres & seventy six perches and allowance &c in-
cluding the vacant land adjoining Robert Montgomery's
Land And excluding the part extending eastward.
