


In pursuance of a warrant dated the 22nd day of August in the year of one thousand seven hundred and ninety three 1793 Surveyed the 1st day of February 1819 for Mordica Roberts the above described Tract on a warrant Granted by the land office to William Bingham adjoining Mordica Roberts to the land and the River Lackawaxen in Backawan Township (formerly Northampton Co) now Pike Co.
