



The above is a draught of a tract of land Surveyed to Samuel Buchanan on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795 in pursuance of Warrant dated Febr<sup>y</sup>. 3<sup>rd</sup> 1794 By John Moor a former Deputy Surveyor Containing Four hundred and five acres & One hundred & five perches with an allowance of Six per Cent & Situate N.W. of the Allegheny river on the Waters of Buffaloe Creek & Taken from his draught now in my possession which I have examoned and find Correct Certified this 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1818
