



A Draft of forty nine acres and sixty three perches of land with six per cent for Roads situate in Ferrumanagh township in Mifflin county surveyed 30<sup>th</sup> June 1814 in pursuance of a Warrant to James Allen dated 18<sup>th</sup> March 1795. Note there was an old house standing on the above represented land at time of survey, and land that appeared to have cleared, may be, from 15 to 20 years ago, or upwards.
