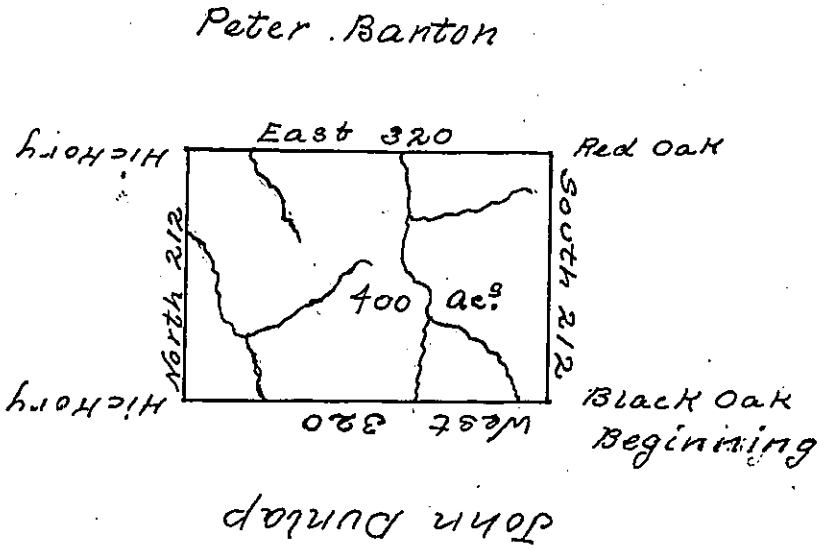

 of Conaquesing Creek Called Dunmow containing
 four Hundred acres and the usual Allowance of six Per
 Cent for Roads
