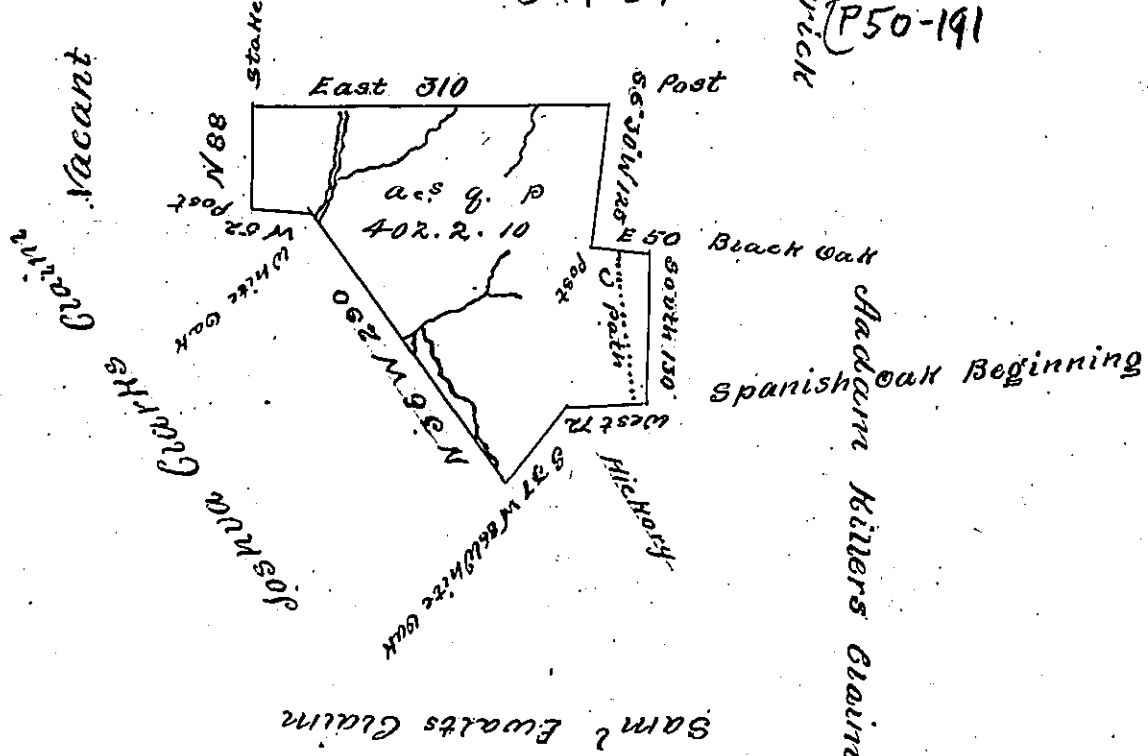

The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 7th 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Jacob Bousman for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794 adjoining Abraham Kirkpatrick to the West including the Waters of a stream that empties into the Ohio north and West of the River Ohio and Alleghany on the Waters of Lauries Run Called the Mill Seat Place containing four Hundred two Acres one half and ten poles together with the usual Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads
