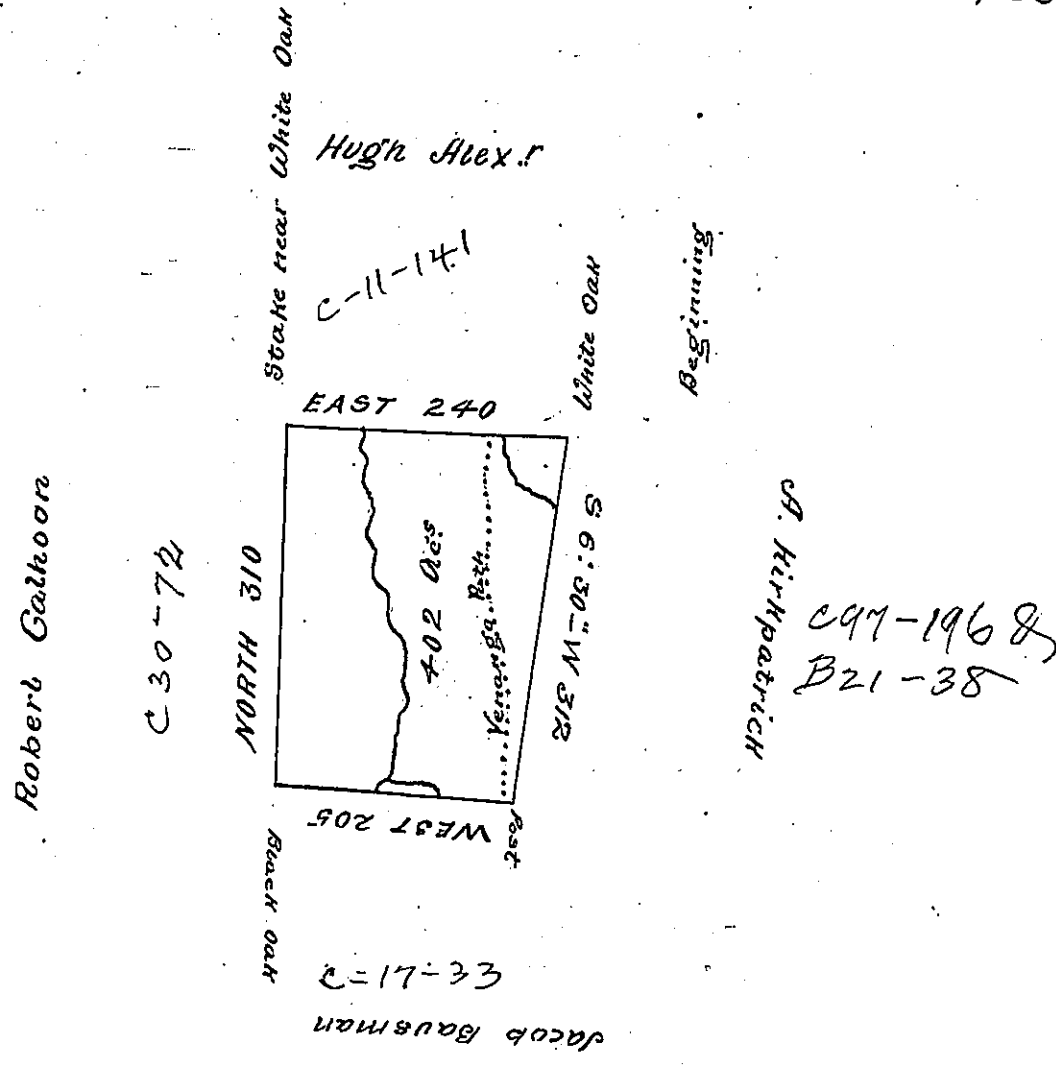

The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 5<sup>th</sup> day 1794 in Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Boyd for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794 adjoining Robert Galhoorn on the East Side and including the Venango Path north and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Alleghany called Retch Hill Containing four Hundred and two Acres together with the usual Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads
