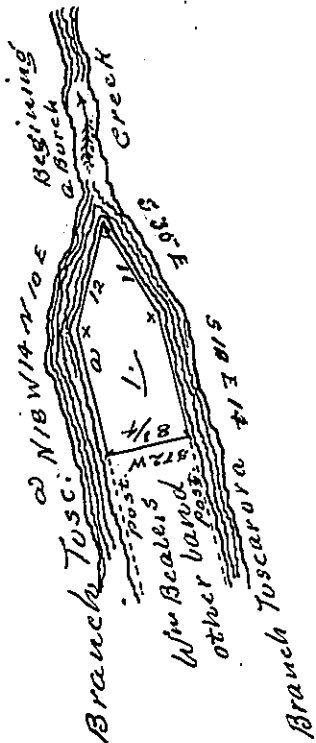

 In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to William Beale of  
 Mifflin County (Farmer) dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March  
 1803 - for vacant and unimproved Land - and also agree-  
 able to an Act of Assembly Passed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March  
 1796 - Entitled an Act to Compensate David Mead  
 and others - Note almost all the above Discribed piece of  
 Land appears Cleared and under Cultivation (Said to be by  
 William Beale the present owner) yet no Dwelling house or place of
