



The above is a Draught of a survey called Three Pinks, situated in Morris Township, Washington County, containing seven acres & forty five perches and the usual allowance. Surveyed May 19<sup>th</sup> 1819, in pursuance of a warrant granted Peter Beabout, dated December 1<sup>st</sup> 1818. At the time of survey there was a cabin on the land, occupied as a schoolhouse, also a small enclosure cleared. I have heard of no adverse claim whatever.
