



Draft of three hundred acres and sixty three perches of land with six per cent for Roads. Situate in Wayne township in Mifflin County which appears from official papers to have been surveyed 27th December 1816 in pursuance of a Warrant to Wallace Bratton dated 11th December 1816. Note, in former part of time of survey an old house and family in it, and old barn and near one hundred acres of land under fences & in a state of cultivation etc
