



Situated in Warrior Mark Township Huntingdon County, containing sixty five acres and allowance of six per Cent &c. first surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John P. Baynton and Samuel Wharton dated 28<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1766 it then contained five hundred and ninety nine acres and allowance of six per Cent &c, this part re-surveyed and divided from the residue of the tract the 2<sup>d</sup> day of Decr. 1819.
