



In pursuance of a warrant granted unto Peter Bastres bearing date the twenty third day of February A.D. 1813, there was surveyed unto him on the 18th of June following the above described tract of land situated in Schuylkill township in the county of Schuylkill containing four hundred acres & 126 perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
