



The above is a Draught of a survey made the 2^d of February, 1795, in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Brown for 400 acres of land dated the 4th of January, 1794, Situated north and west of the River Ohio on the waters of Slippery Rock Creek - adjoining Land granted to Peter Barton - Called Blackberry, containing four Hundred acres and the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads.
