



Situated in the New Purchase, Pinecreek Township Lycoming County adjoining George Tomb's survey, on the road leading from Jersey Shore on the N B of Susquehanna to Cowdens port on the Allegany river about fourteen miles from the Jersey shore Survey'd on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1815, by Virtue of a warrant granted to Peter Bastres dated the 28<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1814, No. 6066, Containing four hundred and thirty six acres & ninety nine perches & allowance of six M. Ct. for Roads,

Note, The improvement is a house with a farm thereon about two acres cleared Land,
