



Warrant dated y^e 23^d of Feb. 1733

Surveyed on the Twenty fifth day of March 1734 To Moses Coats a Tract of land Situate on the East Side of ye River Schuylkill. Beginning at a Hickery tree Standing on the Bank of ye s^d River thence by land of Christian Marree North Seventy Degrees three hundred & Seventy two perches to a post thence by Vacant land South Twenty Degrees East one hundred and fourteen perches to a Small Black oak Saplin thence by land of Thomas Collins South Seventy Degrees West three hundred and Seventy to a Maple tree on ye Bank of ye s^d River thence Up the Same to ye place of Beginning Containing Two hundred and fifty Acres with Usual Allowance

Now Berks County.
