



A Draught of a part of a Tract of Land originally Surveyed and Returned into the Surveyor Generals Office for Frederick Hill on Application N<sup>o</sup> 427 dated 3<sup>d</sup> April 1769. Situated on Holland run adjoining land Surveyed for Jacob Conrad and Detrick Matthews. But by the Execution of an earlier Order in the Name of Thomas Barnes N<sup>o</sup> 154 forty eight<sup>acres</sup> and 120 ps & All<sup>s</sup> was taken out of Fred<sup>s</sup> Hills Survey agreeably to the dotted lines which has been already Patented And the Residue being two hundred and fifty one Acres & 40 ps & allowance is yet remaining to Frederick Hill. - Certified this 11<sup>th</sup> of Aug<sup>r</sup> 1801.
