



A draft of a tract of land situated in Oneida township, Huntingdon county, containing fifty-six acres, ninety-two perches, and allowance of six per cent - being a part of a larger tract of land which was first surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Clement Biddle, dated the 3rd day of June, 1763, -

Re-surveyed and divided from the residue of said tract on the 3rd day of July, 1822, by William Reed, then Deputy Surveyor, whose field notes, I have examined and approved, this 13th day of October, 1864
