



The above is a draft of 175^{ac.} & 1^{pt.} with allowance situate in Salem Township Mercer County adjoining lands of John Stewart on the North, Joseph Brush on the East, Thomas Simpson on the South, William Lindsey on the West, surveyed the 3^d of November 1821 in pursuance of the Settlement residence and improvement of James Brush which appears to have been an early improvement; about 50 acres cleared, a house and barn, and a family thereon no adverse claim made known to me
