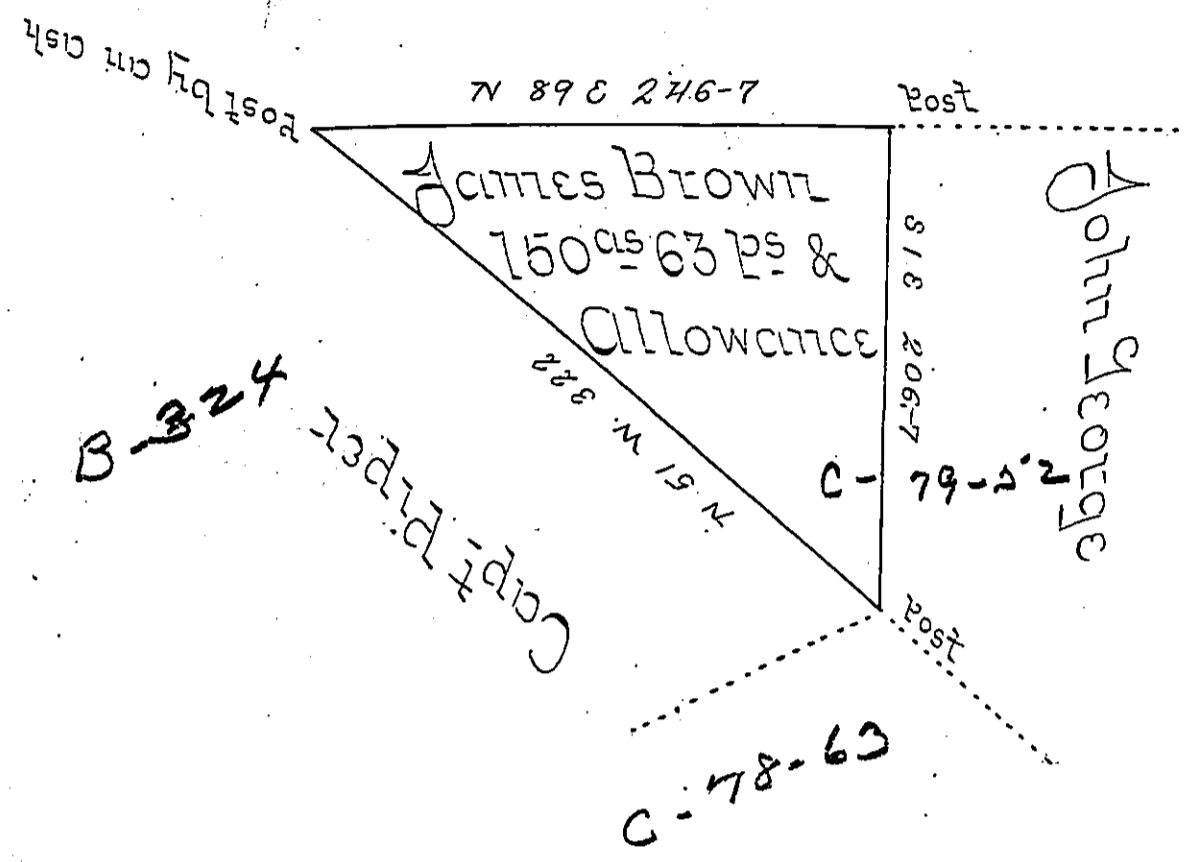


Carson's Land
