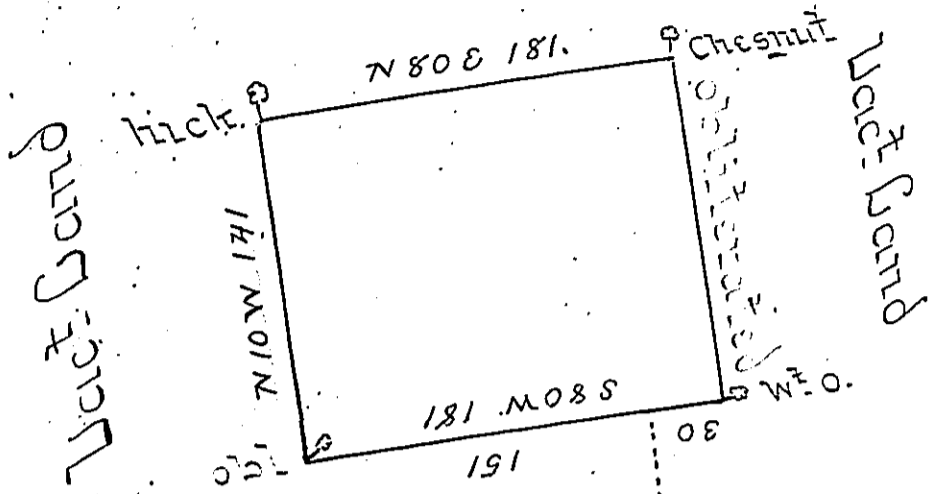


Vacant Land



Vacant Land W. O. (old)

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Thirteenth day of August 1732 Surveyed unto Hans Olinor a tract of Land situate on Maconge run in the County of Bucks Beginning at a White Oak in a line of S^r Krim's land thence by the same South Eighty degrees West thirty perches to a hickory a Corner of S^r Krim's land thence the same Course by Vacant Land one hundred and fifty one perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North Ten degrees West one hundred and forty one perches to a hickory thence by Vacant Land North Eighty degrees East one hundred & eighty one perches (obl.) Chesnut thence by Vacant Land South Ten degrees East one hundred and forty one perches to the place of Beginning containing one hundred and fifty Acres with the usual Allowance of six Percent Surveyed Sept. 10th 1754
