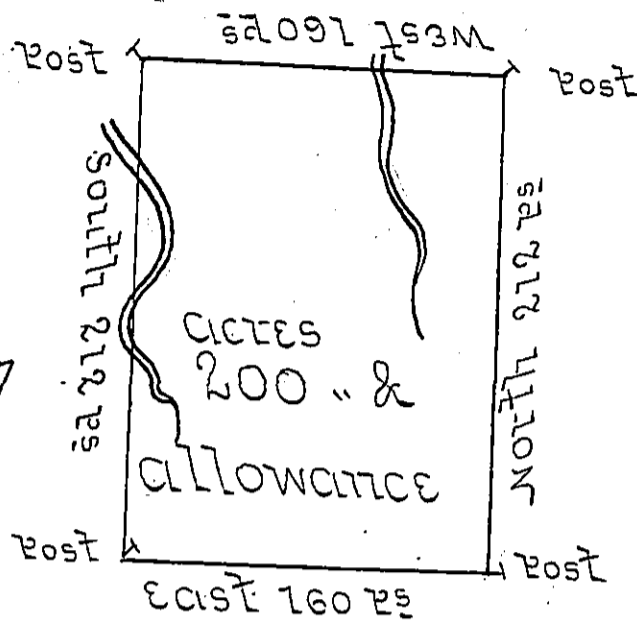

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pens<sup>a</sup> - to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 The above tract of land containing two Hundred Acres and allowance of six P<sup>er</sup> Cent for Roads &c<sup>a</sup> was surveyed the second day of July 1785 by
